- Chiggers do not burrow in your skin they bite and cause skin to itch leaving red itchy bumps or a rash
- Bears
- Flooding links to Suwanne River Management River levels
- Dirt Roads are sometimes smooth and sometimes rough. It is 3 miles of dirt road to access any of the
- Steinhatchee or Suwanne properties.
- Spring Bottoms have natural limestone base and are very course on the feet
- No Diving because there may be branches from fallen trees in the springs.
